Available from Golf Carts Limited, 1-724-368-3221. *Must be ordered ahead. Only two riders at a time. Driver must be over 18. Carts must be driven responsibly. These rules will be strictly enforced by the show management.*

GR 1401.29 Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent (s), guardian (s), and/or trainer (s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

GENERAL INFORMATION & RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRIES: Shall be on the official show entry form. No horse should be entered on more than one entry form and must be entered in the name of the Legal Owner. The entry form should be complete in every detail; otherwise the record of wins may not be properly credited. Show management reserves the right to return any incomplete entry form. A horse should be entered in the name of the LEGAL OWNER only. Leased or co-owned horses of persons not of the same family cannot be shown in OWNER classes. ENTRY MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A COPY OF EACH HORSE'S REGISTRATION PAPER, CURRENT AHA & USEF MEMBERSHIP CARDS OR THE APPROPRIATE NON-MEMBER FEES AND NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST.

POST ENTRIES. *Closing date is April 27, 2009.* Entries postmarked after this date will automatically be considered post entries and assessed a post entry fee. Post entries for horses and equitation riders will be accepted any time up to one half hour before the morning, afternoon or evening performance session in which the horse or equitation rider is to be shown.

CONDITION OF ENTRY. The show committee and management reserve the right to refuse, accept conditionally or cancel any entry, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and remove from the grounds any individual, stable or both without claim to damages.

PERMISSION FOR MINORS. A parent or guardian must sign permission.

TRAINER AND OWNER MUST BOTH sign the entry form. If the owner is also the trainer, then the owner must sign TWICE. If the trainer is also the agent for the owner, then the trainer must sign TWICE.

AMATEUR EXHIBITORS. Any person having reached his/her 18th birthday prior to 12/1/08 must have an amateur card issued yearly by USEF or apply for such card at least one hour prior to showing in an Amateur class. Applications may be found in the show office and submitted to the show secretary. *All horses showing in AAOTR, AOTR or JOTR classes must have registration papers in the name of the exhibitor or a family member as defined by USEF GR-122.*

NATIONAL SHOW HORSE OWNERS. Owners are required to provide show management with proof of NSHR registration. *A copy of the official NSHR certificate of registration or confirmation letter must accompany entry.* Pending registration will not be accepted.

JUNIOR EXHIBITORS. Shall not have reached their 18th birthday. For horse show purposes, the age of the junior exhibitor on December 1st of the show year shall be maintained throughout the entire year.

USEF PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR RULE. Except as may otherwise be mandated by local law, all juniors riding in Hunter Seat Equitation sections must wear properly fitting protective headgear passing or surpassing current applicable ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards with harness secured while riding anywhere on the competition grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitting

PRE-ENTRY CLOSING IS APRIL 27, 2009

PAYMENT OF FEES. All money must accompany the entry form and be paid before numbers can be issued. Any additional charges must be paid before leaving the show grounds. Any unpaid charges will be invoiced and failure to pay the invoice within 30 days will be considered a non-sportsmanlike act and may result in actions taken against such conduct in accordance with USEF rules. There will be a \$50.00 charge for returned checks and failure to check out.

REFUNDS. Withdrawal of entries must be made in writing and accompanied by a veterinarian certificate. Those received before entry closing date will be refunded all fees except office fees. After entry closing and before the start of the show, all fees will be refunded except office and stall fee. During the show only class fees, less classes already shown in, will be refunded. No refunds on Dressage or Sport Horse classes.

SHOW RING FOOTING. Footing in competition and warm-up rings consists of crushed limestone. Unlimited grass warm-up is available. Ring sizes: Ring A—250' x 145', Ring C—235' x 135', Ring D—220' x 125'. Office Phone: 724-652-0206.

STABLING. *There are 208 permanent horse stalls.* Barns contain spacious stalls with full partitions and permanent sliding doors. Wash rack areas are located outside barn area. Facilities feature restrooms with showers, a centralized office and concession area with covered seating. All horses must either have a stall or pay the \$25 grounds fee per day. Stalls will be assigned as entries are received **and will not be reserved without payment.** Exhibitors wishing to be stabled together must mail their entries in the same envelope. Additional stalls requested after the original stalls are purchased might not be assigned in the same location. Horses must be in assigned stalls. No change will be permitted except by consent of the barn manager. Any exhibitor using a stall not assigned will be charged a penalty fee of \$50.00 in addition to the fee for assigned stall.

TACK STALL guidelines will be enforced using the following table. Single horse exhibitors are encouraged to make stall reservations with other single-horse exhibitors in order to share a tack stall: 2-3 horses/1 tack; 4-6 horses/2 tack; 7-9 horses/3 tack; 10-13 horses/four tack; 14-17 horses/five tack; 18-21 horses/six tack; 22 + 7 tack (maximum). Patrons will receive a preferential basis for stabling as part of their patron package. Patron stalling will also be based on prior years stalling location and availability.

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE. Arrival after 9:00 a.m. Friday, May 8. Departure on Sunday May 10. For Monday departure, you must contact the show manager in advance.

PARKING. Campers, horse vans and trailers must be parked in designated areas. Parking is not allowed next to barn areas except for loading and unloading of vehicles.

BEDDING. Exhibitors should pre-order shavings. (\$7.00 per bag). If ordered at show, (\$7.25 per bag) the shavings form available at the show office must be completed before delivery. Exhibitors may bring their own bedding, however the grounds owners do not allow straw bedding.

SHARPS CONTAINERS. A Sharps container will be designated for each barn for the disposal of needles and other sharp disposable instruments in convenient locations. See USEF GR-1211.5 posted in the show office.

FEED. Contact the show office for information about feed vendors.

FARRIER AND VETERINARIAN. A Veterinarian will be on call. Services will be available on a private fee basis.

DOGS. All dogs on the show grounds must be on a leash. GR-301,

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS. A Negative Coggins Test Certificate dated within a year of the show must be sent with entries. Post entrants must present to cancel, combine or divide any class to accommodate for an insufficient or excessive number of entries.

JUDGES. In the event a judge or other official is unable to perform his/her duties, the show committee reserves the right to substitute an official for the one designated in the prize list according to USEF rules.

CRUELTY AND ABUSE TO A HORSE. Acts of cruelty or abuse of a horse by any person at a recognized competition show is forbidden. Excessive use of the whip on any horse in stall, runway, schooling area, show ring, or elsewhere on the show grounds before or during a show constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty (USEF GR-302).

AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. All horses entered in any AHA approved show must be owned by an AHA member or the horse owner will pay an additional fee of \$30.00 to AHA. Exhibitors in non-award point classes including walk/trot and lead line are exempted from paying the AHA non-member fee (Res. 28-90.) Membership in AHA is required for trainers, drivers, riders and halter handlers.

CLASS CALLS. As a courtesy to exhibitors, the public address system will be used to make barn calls. However, EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR SEEING THAT ENTRIES REACH THE GATE ON TIME AND SHOULD NOT RELY SOLELY ON THE P.A. SYSTEM.

TWO-MINUTE RULE. Exhibitors will be allowed a maximum of two (2) minutes to enter the ring from the time the first horse enters the ring.

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES. To be eligible to show in a performance championship class a horse must have been properly entered, shown and judged in a qualifying class

CANCELLATIONS OF CLASS. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class to accommodate for an insufficient or excessive number of entries.

RULES. This show is conducted in accordance with the current USEF rules, the AHA Handbook and NSHR rules where they apply respectively. Any rule changes or corrections will automatically become part of this prize list. Each participant is subject to and responsible for knowledge of USEF/AHA/NSHR rules. Questions not covered by USEF/AHA/NSHR rules will be decided by the show committee and its decisions will be final.

DISCOURTESY. Any act of discourtesy to the judges or officials on the part of the owner, rider, groom, exhibitor or driver shall disqualify the horse from being judged, and the owner shall forfeit all fees paid and monies won. Management reserves the right to remove any of the aforementioned without being liable for compensation or damages.

US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION STATEMENT

LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES PROVIDED THE RESPECTIVE BREED/DISCIPLINE DUES OR BREED/DISCIPLINE CATEGORY FEE HAS BEEN PAID. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR MEMBER COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30 NON-MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE: 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK/TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (ACADEMY CLASSES ARE LIMITED TO HORSES USED REGULARLY IN A LESSON PROGRAM); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES; 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION; 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES. EC 7/21/08 EFFECTIVE 12/1/08.

ARABIAN REGISTRY REQUIREMENTS. Horses in this Division must have a Certificate of Registration from the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc. or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry. If under one year of age, the horse must be eligible for registry and applied for registration. (Only weanlings who have applied for registration may show without registration papers). The horse must be entered under its full registered name. (USEF AR-101).

HALF-ARABIAN REGISTRY REQUIREMENTS. Horses in this Division must have a Certificate of Registration from AHA in the Half-Arabian Registry or the Anglo-Arabian Registry, or have a CPAR permit. If under one year of age, the horse must be eligible for registry and applied for registration. (Only weanlings who have applied for registration may show without registration papers.) The horse must be entered under its full registered name USEF (AR-236).

NATIONAL SHOW HORSE REGISTRY REQUIREMENTS. All exhibitors of National Show Horses must provide the show secretary with the original or copy of the NSHR Certificate of Registration or Confirmation Letter with their entries.

NSH/UPHA CHALLENGE CUP. Open to all NSH saddle seat equitation riders, 17 and under. Must be a member of United Professional Horsemen's Association (See page 20 for class specifications).

HIGH POINT YOUTH CHALLENGE CUP*. A trophy sponsored by *Empress Arabians* will be presented to the youth with the most overall points accumulated on one horse in the show. Open to all youths, in accordance with the USEF Junior classification (GR-126). **All participating youth must register at the show office at least one hour before entering the first class and provide a list of classes entered along with exhibitor numbers. Classes entered before registering will not count for points.** Exhibitors may enter multiple horses. This award is perpetual and must be returned when recalled. An exhibitor who wins the award for three consecutive years will be entitled to retain it. Points may be accumulated in JTR, JOTR or Open classes as follows with points doubled for Championship Performance classes:

AHA MEDAL CLASSES

Open to juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1. The AHA Medal classes shall be governed by USEF Rules, Arabian Division for Equitation. *Medal winners may ride in any Medal class throughout the year. (BOD1/02)*

AHA SADDLE SEAT MEDAL CLASS

1. Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF Tests 1-15. Markers shall not be used.

AHA REINING SEAT MEDAL CLASS

1. All contestants are required to perform a Reining pattern as outlined in USEF Reining..
2. Other tests may be included from USEF EQ 125.
3. Dropping of bits is optional with the judge but if called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials.
4. Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.
5. In an AHA Reining Seat Medal class an off pattern rider is eliminated and is not eligible to win a medal or ribbon.
6. The prescribed AHA Reining Seat Equitation Score Sheet must be used and posted in accordance with USEF rule AR199.5 (Res. 25-06).

AHA HUNTER SEAT NOT TO JUMP MEDAL CLASS

1. Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from AHA Article 1336.9.

AHA WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP MEDAL CLASS

1. Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform a minimum of four tests from USEF AR222. (BOD 5/06).

NSH/UPHA CHALLENGE CUP

Open to riders 17 years of age and under, riding a National Show Horse mare or gelding. The United Professional Horsemen's Association (UPHA) National Show Horse Challenge Cup was established in 1989 and the National Championship is held at the National Show Horse Finals in Springfield, IL. The UPHA Challenge Cup is considered a "local" class. Therefore, the USAE ruling which prohibits pleasure equitation riders from cross-entering between regular and pleasure equitation classes at the same show does not apply. A win of a UPHA breed Challenge cup class (NSH) eliminates the rider from further competition in that respective class for the remainder of the qualifying season. The UPHA Challenge Cup judging specifications are to be read by the announcer as the riders enter the ring.

1. Showmanship is paramount throughout the class.
2. Judging in all UPHA Challenge Cup qualifying classes is based 60% on rail work and 40% on the individual workout.
3. In all qualifying classes, the top four (4) riders must be worked individually; more may be worked at the judge's discretion.
4. The mandatory workout in all qualifying competitions (except 10 & under walk/trot classes) is: "Trot a serpentine to the opposite end of the ring. Return down either rail at a show trot." Judges are not permitted to alter the mandatory workout in any manner.
